ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

The objective of this exhibition is to recognize, encourage and nurture excellence in photographic art practice. Amateur and professional photographers are invited to submit artworks shot on film or shot digitally including altered and unaltered photographs, and experimental and mixed media photographic techniques.

JURORS

The jurors will review all submissions, select works for the exhibition and allocate awards and prizes. **Sara Angelucci** is a photo and video artist living in Toronto. She has exhibited her photography across Canada and is represented by the Wynick/Tuck Gallery and V Tape in Toronto. **Dale Barrett** is Director of the John B. Aird Gallery. He has worked in the public gallery sector for the past 25 years and since 1998 has maintained an independent arts administration and graphic design practice.

HOW TO ENTER

Submissions will be juried by digital image.

- Artists may submit up to two (jpeg formatted) digital images on a CD (CDs will not be returned). Each jpeg file must be no more than 1.5 MB in size, and labeled as follows: **Artist's Last Name, Artist's First Name, Title, Size (Height x Width), Date of completion.jpg** (ie: Smith, John, Its a Photograph, 8.5x 11, 2009.jpg).
- All photographs must be original, created by the artist who is submitting, and not previously shown at the John B. Aird Gallery
- There are no size limitations for photographs. All accepted works must be framed (exceptions will be made for oversize work) and fitted with hanging devices, and clearly labeled on the back with the name of the artist, title, medium, size, date of production and sale price.

- The Gallery Director has the right to not hang any work which does not conform to entry rules or was misrepresented on the submission CD, whether intentionally or unintentionally.
- Mail or drop off a completed entry form, jpeg images on CD, entry fee, and one page biography to: **John B. Aird Gallery, 900 Bay Street, Toronto, ON M7A 1C2.**

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$30. This fee covers entry of up to two works per artist, is non-refundable and must be mailed with the entry form. Please make your cheque or money order payable to: **John B. Aird Gallery.**

JURYING

The jurors will meet and review submissions on Monday, April 26, 2010.

JURY RESULTS

Artists will be notified by email or telephone of the jury's decision by Wednesday, April 28, 2010.

DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORKS

Artists must deliver accepted work(s) to the John B. Aird Gallery, 900 Bay Street, Toronto, on Saturday, May 1, between noon and 3:00 pm.

AWARDS

The jurors will assign cash awards: First Prize, \$300; Second Prize, \$200; Third Prize, \$100. Gift certificates from sponsors may also be awarded.

EXHIBITION DATES & RECEPTION

The exhibition will be on view from May 4 - 28, 2010. An opening reception will be held on Thursday, May 6, from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m.

PICK-UP OF WORKS / EXHIBITION CLOSING

At the end of the exhibition participating artists must pick-up their works on Saturday, May 29, between 10:00 a.m. and noon.

SALES

Artists will be informed of sales inquiries and must forward the gallery a 30% commission on all sales.

INSURANCE

Artists are responsible for the payment of an insurance deductible (\$1,000) for each claim. In the case of a group claim, (made on behalf of two or more artists), this cost will be averaged among the claimants. Works in the exhibition are insured at the retail price less 30%. Claims may be subject to an appraisal to determine the fair market value of the work.

ABOUT THE JOHN B. AIRD GALLERY

The John B. Aird Gallery, formerly the Macdonald Gallery was reopened in May of 1985 as a result of an agreement concluded between the Ministry of Intergovernmental Affairs on behalf of the Government of Ontario and six visual arts organizations, namely: Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour, Ontario Crafts Council, Ontario Society of Artists, Royal Canadian Academy of Arts, Society of Canadian Artists, and Sculptors Society of Canada.

The mission of the Gallery is to foster public awareness and enjoyment of artworks by contemporary professional artists. The Gallery endeavours to recognize, encourage and nurture excellence in the visual arts. To this end, exhibitions and educational programs, showcasing emerging and established artists and their works, are organized and presented.
